2.2 Intended use

2.2.1 Areas of application

The concealed cistern 3L is suitable for mounting a floor-standing WC and for walling in or around. Flush actuation is possible from the front.

This model is equipped with dual flush technology and is delivered without flush plates. For complete mounting, a WC flush plate for Prevista must be purchased additionally.

The cistern is designed to supply cold water. The application limits must be taken into account for the cold water supply, see % 'Regulations from section: Application areas' on page 5.




Fig. 1: Components





Fig. 2: Dimensional drawing




3.2 Assembly


3.2.1 Mounting concealed cistern



■ Break the locking clips off the wall mountings.




- Push the wall mountings into the mounting brackets.
- Insert the locking clips.




- Adjust the construction height of the concealed cistern in accordance with the on-site marking of the upper edge of the finished floor.
- Mark the fixing points.






- Drill the holes.
- Insert the dowels.



- Align the concealed cistern.
- Tighten the concealed cistern via the mounting brackets using a fork spanner.
 - □ The concealed cistern is attached to the wall.






For actuation from the top, maintain a minimum distance of 30 mm from the front edge of the tile to the shaft.




Mounting in the timber stud frame




- Cut out recesses for the drain elbow and the flush plate in the prewall finish.
- Align the concealed cistern on the pre-wall finish.
- Tighten the concealed cistern via the mounting brackets.
 - □ The concealed cistern is fastened.

3.2.2 Connecting concealed cistern




Turn the site protection panel lock 90° anti-clockwise.




Remove the site protection panel.






- Place the press connector onto the water supply.
- Press the connection.
- Seal the threaded connectors of the corner valve.
- Screw the corner valve into the thread side of the press connector.




- Remove the plug.
- Insert the corner valve into the cistern.

INFO! Observe the proper fit of the corner valve.




Use the lock nut to screw the corner valve and the cistern to each other.




- Remove the protective cap from the flexible hose.
- Screw the flexible hose and the corner valve to each other hand tight.
- Set the flush volume as applicable, *♦ Chapter 3.2.4 'Setting the flush volume'* on page 17.





■ Insert the site protection panel into the cistern.



■ Turn the site protection panel's lock by 90° clockwise.



▶ Place the inspection shaft on the site protection panel.







To remove the inspection shaft, press in the fixing clips at the side.




Conversion of the actuation from above



■ Remove the cover and insert at the front.




▶ Place the inspection shaft on the site protection panel.




For actuation from the top, maintain a minimum distance of 30 mm from the front edge of the tile to the shaft.




3.2.3 Setting up and cladding the concealed cistern



Fit the protective plug of the flushing pipe.




Brick in the concealed cistern.



NOTICE! Do not load the concealed cistern.






■ The wall construction must be at least 10 mm.

Installation from above:




3.2.4 Setting the flush volume

Requirements:


- The cistern is freely accessible.
- The water supply has been shut off.
- The ceramic has been mounted.
- Fold the tabs forward.




Lift the drain valve.




■ Remove the drain valve through the revision opening.








Set the large flush volume at the drain valve.



Set the small flush volume at the drain valve.




Setting the flush flow



Requirements:

- The drain valve has been dismounted.
- The flushing throttle has been removed.
- Unlock the flushing throttle.
- Set the flush flow at the throttle.



Lock the flushing throttle.

3.3 Cleaning and maintenance

Cleaning and maintenance of the concealed cistern

The concealed cistern is constantly under mechanical, chemical, and physical stress. For this reason, the components must be cleaned as required, and the drain and filling valve seals renewed.

In areas or regions with hard water due to high concentration of calcium or magnesium salts, there is the risk of limescale deposits developing on the inlet and drain valves. The valves may have to be replaced, depending on the extent of the deposits.

3.4 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
